



How to Apply

IT STARTS WITH A CLICK.

From submitting your application to the fun and excitement of visit day, this simple “how to” guide tells you everything you need to know about applying to University Liggett School. If you need help, just call the Admissions Office at 313.884.4444. We’ll be glad to connect with you and answer any questions.

- 1. Apply online.** To get started, simply tap on “Apply” at uls.org and submit your application along with a \$50 application fee.
- 2. Complete a parent questionnaire.** After applying, complete the parent questionnaire you receive from the Admissions Associate. (Students applying for Grades 6 – 12 must also complete a student questionnaire.)
- 3. Provide school transcripts.** Parents of school-age applicants must sign a transcript release and present it to the guidance counselor or authorize the applicant’s current school to release a copy of their academic records.
- 4. Collect teacher recommendations.** After applying, you’ll receive teacher recommendation forms that must be completed and returned by the applicant’s current teachers. These include early childhood observations for our youngest students, teacher recommendations for grades 1 – 6, and math and english teacher recommendations for grades 7 – 12.
- 5. Schedule a school visit.*** This age appropriate visit allows prospective students to experience a typical school day and meet current students. Applications and parent/student questionnaires must be submitted at last three days prior to the visit.
- 6. Complete grade-specific assessments.*** On the visit day, prekindergarten and kindergarten applicants will be evaluated for school readiness, while those in grades 1 – 5 will be assessed on math and literacy. Middle and upper school applicants must participate in the entrance assessment on one of the following dates:

 - Middle School**
Saturday, January 15, 2021
Saturday, February 26, 2021
- 7. Attend parent conference.** An informal parent meeting is required for all candidates. While most conferences take place on visit day, they may be scheduled by appointment at any time during the application process.

**During the 2020-21 school year, visits, meetings, and assessments may be conducted in an alternate format to ensure everyone’s health and safety. Your Admissions Director will provide you with detailed information regarding completing these steps.*

When will I know?

Any applicant completing the application process by January 16, 2021 will receive an admissions decisions in early **February 2021**.

Any Applicant that has completed the application process by February 27, 2021 will receive a decision by **mid-March 2021**.

If spaces remain in a grade, applications received after the deadlines will be communicated on a rolling basis.
